

It develops in students the ability to research information, apply problemsolving strategies and evaluate options in order to make informed and responsible decisions as individuals and as part of the community.



It provides students with a broader understanding of the discipline of Geography and the processes of geographical inquiry, and enables depth studies through flexible programming of focus areas.



VET Package Retail and Business Services

Students complete Cluster Tasks which holistically assess their competency across units and upon completing and being deemed competent in all clusters across the two subject areas, students will receive their Certificate I in Retail and Business Services.

Work placement does NOT occur in Stage 5 VET.

Students are required to obtain a Unique Student Identifier (USI) in order to receive their certificates.
