Devices that do not meet this standard will not be able to connect to the NSW Department of Education wireless network.

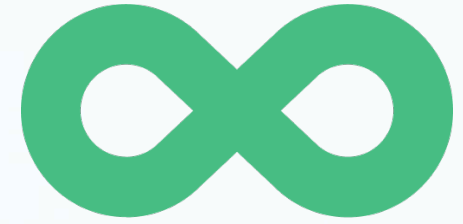
